



1. Who may register in IA ACCESS?

Answer: A person who is or represents an Interested Party as defined in Section 771(9) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1677(9)), may register in IA ACCESS as an E-Filer to electronically file documents. Registered E-Filers will also receive email notifications of public documents and public versions released by the Department in those Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Proceedings in which the E-Filer participates as, or on behalf of, an Interested Party.

A person who is not an Interested Party may register as a Guest User to access public documents or public versions filed in IA ACCESS.
